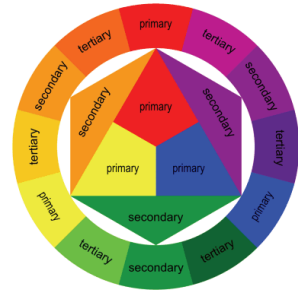

A Level Fine Art

The A Level course is a two year course that consists of four Units, two coursework units and two exam units and a portfolio.

AS Fine Art

The first year of the course concentrates on one main unit
Titled:

Who am I and where do
I come from?

Alongside the coursework unit you build a body of work that shows your skills in a variety of media and this work forms the portfolio element of the programme.

Entry Requirements:

Any Art, Design and/or Textiles qualification grade B or above. Consideration may be given to students wanting to be accepted on the course, who cannot meet this requirement on the strength of submission of a strong portfolio, interview and probationary period.

A2 Fine Art

The second year of the course concentrates on a personal Investigation. This is an entirely independent project and allows you to explore an artist, theme or issue that is important to you. You will produce a series of works supported by a written investigation of 1000/3000 words.

Exams

Each year you will take an externally set Art exam. The exam is similar to the coursework element in preparation but with a timed supervised final outcome. The exam at AS is 5hrs, at A2 15hrs.
