

# Award/Cert in Childcare & Education Level 1 & 2:

<b>Entry Requirements:</b>	You will be expected to have a genuine interest in working with children and a commitment to hard work and have achieved E or D grades in your GCSE's. This course will require all students to take part in a variety of learning styles which will include presentations, role plays and group activities. You will have the right attitude towards learning and be willing to participate in all activities.
<b>Course Content:</b>	<p>Caring for children as they develop from birth to sixteen years of age.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• An introduction to working with children</li> <li>• The developing child</li> <li>• Safe, healthy and nurturing environments for children</li> <li>• Children and play</li> <li>• Communication and professional skills</li> <li>• The child care practitioner in the workplace</li> <li>• Working with children from birth to age 5 years</li> <li>• Tutorials</li> <li>• Key skills communications</li> </ul> <p>Course Assessment By assignments with a multiple choice question paper towards the end of the course, and satisfactory work placement reports.</p>
<b>Progression into careers via:</b>	This course is designed for those who wish to work with children in a wide variety of situations e.g. working in a Playgroup, Crèche, Day Nursery or as a Nanny.
<b>Further Information:</b>	This course is taught alongside ICT Level 2 and is equivalent to 4 GCSE's This qualification leads to employment with vulnerable groups of people., therefore applicants are required to have a clean police record and have police clearance before embarking on the programme. CRB forms are available from College.
<b>Length of Course:</b>	One-year, which can be extended to a Level 3 course

<b>Periods Per Week:</b>	20 Hours per week
