In order to access the level 3 BTEC in Health and Social Care it is essential that you have at least 5 A-C grade GCSE's, one of which must be English. Whether you study the single or the double award you will not have an exam; all assessments will be completed through coursework based tasks. All students will have strict deadlines to adhere to and will be expected to carry out independent study; grading is Pass, Merit and Distinction.

There is a vocational aspect to the course and students will be expected to go out into the workplace during Enrichment time.
