



SCHOOL UNIFORM

All pupils are required to wear uniform at all times; the uniform is warm and practical and represents excellent value.

Clothing is embroidered with the school logo and the name of the pupil's House.

Pupils are required to wear:

- Black shoes (Trainers are NOT acceptable)
- Black trousers or skirt (jeans & tracksuits are NOT acceptable)
- A school polo shirt (white) in polyester/cotton pique fabric with a collar
- A school sweatshirt (Maroon)

The wearing of clothing bearing other logos, brand names etc is NOT allowed.

Details of sports clothing are enclosed.

All uniform enquiries are dealt with by Miss Clements.

The school's dress code limits jewellery to one pair of ear studs, one ring and one wrist watch. Any other jewellery, including nose and tongue studs, is NOT acceptable.

Prospective parents are also required to note that mobile phones and headphones are NOT permitted; items brought into school against school rules will be confiscated and only returned to parents. Repeated offences will lead to exclusion.

It is essential for parents to offer the school full support in all areas relating to the appearance of pupils. Pupils who do not conform to the requirements on dress (including jewellery) will not be admitted to school.

It is the school's belief that uniform and a clean and tidy appearance contribute substantially to the smooth running of the school and to the creation of an effective learning environment.

For reasons of safety and hygiene, pupils are expected to wear the school P.E. kit as they are expected to wear the school uniform.
